Adaniya owned the five-star restaurant Trio in Chicago before going into semiretirement and moving to Hawaii, where his parents, Wallace and Yo Adaniya, once ran a hot dog stand in Kapiolani Park.

His Obama dog starts with an island favorite, a Portuguese-sausage dog piled with Chicago-style trimmings, what he calls "a condiment overload" of mustard, onion, "very green relish," tomato, pickle, spicy peppers and celery salt.
